Summary:

The District received 40 complaints during the 1st quarter of 2024, which is a slight decrease over the 4th quarter of 2024 which saw 46 total complaints. 60% of all complaints were smoke occurring from either open burning or wood stoves. Field investigations were performed on 30% of complaints with 1 NTC being issued for a repeat offender that conducted a broadcast burn on a No Burn Day.
